WHITE ORNAMENT DOUGH





4 Ingredients

Baking & Spices 1 cup Baking Soda ½ cup Cornstarch Liquids ¾ cup Water

Snacks

1 Cookie cutters

CREAM ORNAMENT DOUGH

Salt Dough Recipe

- · 2 cups flour (plus more for rolling out)
- · 1 cup of salt
- 3/4 to 1 cup of water (more or less).
- Toothpick for making the holes for hanging.
- · Jute twine or ribbon or String for hanging.



We had a lot of fun making these with other children in our church community. Below are a couple of pics from the batch we made. We did not bother baking them, instead let them air dry for 5 days. So make the dough and cut the

shapes one weekend and decorate the next!
